### College and Career Readiness (CCR)

#### Goals

**Graduation Rate:** Increase graduation rate for all students from 79% in the 2020-2023 cohort to 82% in the 2021-2024 cohort.

**On Track for Grade 9:** Increase the percentage of students who are promoted to Grade 10 per the Overlea promotional guide from 80% (320/400) in 2023 to 83% (295/356) in 2024.
